Martha is very knowledgable and very thoughtful about how she answers questions—she is good at encouraging questions. You can really tell that she wants us to succeed and that translates into very helpful feedback and interactions in section and office hours

He was very thorough and always wrote follow—up emails after each section if there were questions he didn't get to answer in class.
